



Wading birds are arriving on Isla Alcatraz! A variety of wading bird species have historically used the island as a nesting site. So far this season, the Waterbird Monitoring Program has observed Great Blue Heron (Ardea herodias), Black-crowned Night Heron(Nycticorax nycticorax), Tricolored Heron (Egretta tricolor), Snowy Egret(Egretta thula), Reddish Egret (Egretta rufescens), and White Ibis (Eudocimus albus) in the process of establishing territories and displaying breeding behavior on the island's halophytic vegetation flat.
