In 2017, Amy was awarded the distinct honor Knight of the Order of Arts and Letters (Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres) by the Consul General of France in Louisiana. The award was established in 1957 by the Minister of Culture to recognize those who have contributed significantly to furthering the arts in France and around the world.

In 2008, Kirk-Duvoisin founded the Joan of Arc Project, dedicated to promoting the story of Joan of Arc and French culture. The signature event of the project is an annual Joan of Arc Parade in the French Quarter every January 6, Joan of Arc's birthday (www.joanofarcparade.org). She worked for the City of New Orleans from 2009-2016 as marketing director of the historical French Market District, where, among other things, she helped to promote French heritage by reviving their Bastille Day festivities, including the French Market Waiters Race.

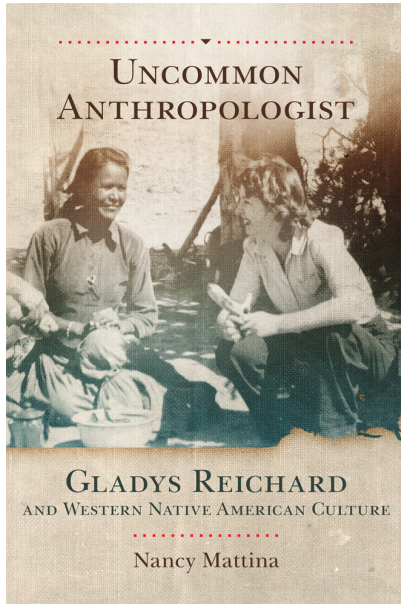
